## EASTON Y DAY CAMP FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



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### QUESTION

**What are the day camp time options?**

### ANSWER

Easton Y Day Camp - 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. for children who completed kindergarten through completed 6th grade.  
Early Bird Care is from 6:30 A.M. -9:00 A.M.  
Night Owl Care is from 4:00 P.M.-6:30 P.M.

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**Do I have to pay a deposit?**

We do not take deposits; however, the first week's tuition and a one-time, non-refundable \$30 registration fee is required.

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**When is my camp tuition due?**

Camp tuition for the first registered session is due at the time of registration. The payment is due on Monday (one week prior to the start of each Day Camp session); a \$15 late fee is assessed for registrations received after 6:00 P.M. on Monday. All forms of payment are accepted. Cash must be received at the Welcome Center in the Main Building. Please retain receipts for your records.

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**Once I have dropped off my packet, am I registered?**

The Welcome Center will accept your child's registration packet for camp. The Camp office will contact you to let you know if there is availability for the week you requested or if you will be put on a waiting list.

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<b>Is there a sibling discount?</b>	We do not offer a sibling discount.
<b>What if my child does not come every day during the week?</b>	Prices are based on a 5-day week. If the child does not attend, then no credit is applied for the day.
<b>What should my child bring to camp daily?</b>	Your child should bring these items daily: a nonperishable nut-free lunch, a morning and afternoon snack, a reusable water bottle, sunscreen, bug spray (optional), a bathing suit, a towel, a bag, or a backpack. Please label all your child's belonging with their first and last name. For the safety of all children, we request your child wear sneakers. <b>Open-toed shoes will not be permitted except during water activities.</b>
<b>What should my child not bring to camp?</b>	<b>The Y is not responsible for lost or damaged items.</b> Please make sure your child keeps all electronic equipment, cell phones, playing/trading cards, and all other toys at home. We strongly encourage items from home to remain at home.
<b>Does my child need a snack or a lunch?</b>	Your child will need a snack and a lunch. <b>**We are a nut-free environment**</b> Please do not send your child to camp with any peanut OR nut products. Lunches should include nonperishable items, as we do not have the capacity to refrigerate or heat camper's lunches/snacks.
<b>What will my child do during the day?</b>	Our Day Camp has a structured daily schedule. Please contact the Day Camp Director for a daily schedule prior to the first day of camp. Any questions should be directed to us at 610-258-6158 Ext. 410 or 413
<b>Will my child have a free swim?</b>	All children will attend free swim in the afternoons Monday through Friday at the Y indoor pool. Campers should come to camp in their bathing suit each day.
<b>Can I see the location of the camp before camp begins?</b>	You will have the opportunity to meet staff and see the site at our Open Houses. Dates and times will be announced at a future date.
<b>What is the earliest I can drop my child off if I do not have AM Extended Care?</b>	The drop-off for campers who do not have AM Extended care is <b>9:00 A.M.</b> Please be mindful of the staff's preparation time and do not leave your child unattended or not signed in.
<b>How can I add or change a session? Can I add extended care options to my camper's registration?</b>	All changes must be made in written form.
