FOR YOUR SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS

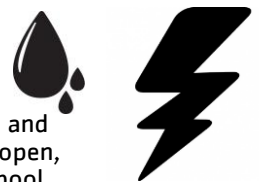
All visitors to the City of Easton Outdoor Pools, Eddyside and Heil, are required to abide by the following rules for the safety and enjoyment of all patrons.

ADMISSION

- NON-MEMBER OUTDOOR POOL PARTICIPANTS MUST SHOW ID WITH THEIR STREET ADDRESS EVERY TIME THEY VISIT! In order to get a resident rate, you must live within the city limits.
- All persons entering the pool facility must sign in and pay daily admission whether or not they intend to swim. Cash or card payments will be accepted.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

- If it is raining and/or if thunder and lightning occurs one hour before the pool is scheduled to open and does not end by 1:30 p.m., then the pool will remain closed for the day.
- If it is raining and/or if thunder and lightning occurs one hour before the pool is scheduled to open but ends by 1:30 p.m., then opening will be delayed until 4:00 p.m. to allow time for staff to arrive.
- If it is an overcast day with imminent bad weather forecasted, then the pool will open as scheduled and stay open until at least 4:00 p.m. The pool may close after this time due to lack of attendance, defined as 10 or less patrons on the grounds for more than one hour.
- If it starts raining and/or thunder and lightning occurs after the pool is open, patrons will be asked to exit the pool and will remain out until 30 minutes after the storm has ceased. If one hour has passed and the weather still prohibits patrons from entering the pool, then the pool will be closed for the day.
- During inclement weather, patrons who have paid for daily admission and have enjoyed 2 hours or less at our facility may pick up a complementary pass for one return day pass visit.
- Refunds for inclement weather will only be offered as a free day pass for another day of swimming outdoors.



GENERAL POOL RULES

- Children 16 years of age and under will only be admitted to the facility when accompanied by a parent/guardian or responsible adult age 19 and older. Children ages 16 and under must be supervised by the accompanying parent/guardian at all times. (Pool members age 14-16 will be admitted without an adult.)
- Children 5 years and under must be accompanied by an adult in the water and within an arm's length of assistance.
- Only SWIM diapers with a bathing suit are permitted for children.
- Proper swimsuits please! Cutoffs, jeans, etc., are prohibited swim wear.
- Persons with stomach infections or open wounds are not permitted in pool to avoid contamination.
- Please enjoy food and drinks only in plastic containers and only on our grassy areas.
- Deposit all trash and recycling in proper receptacles.
- Please respect our family environment! Foul language, running, and rough play prohibited. Conduct that interferes with the enjoyment of others is prohibited.
- All patrons must comply with the Y Core Values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, and Responsibility.
- Smoking or use of smokeless tobacco products are only permitted in the parking lot. Please dispose of cigarette butts in the receptacle provided.
- Secure your personal belongings. The Y is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Goggles that cover the nose are not permitted.
- Only Coast Guard approved Personal Floatation Devices (Type II and Type III PFDs) are allowed in the water. All devices must be checked by management upon entrance.
- Approved Personal Flotation Devices are available from the pool staff for use during your visit.
- Diving only permitted in designated areas.
- Strong swimming ability required for slide use. The lifeguard on duty has the authority to restrict any person from the slides. All swimmers seeking to use the slide and/or swim in deep end must first undergo a safety swim test.
- Free swimming prohibited in the slide area/diving well.
- Patrons must report any injuries to the pool manager. Patrons must complete incident reports.
- Alcohol use is prohibited on pool property. Patrons suspected of intoxication will be asked to leave the premises, at the discretion of a pool manager or the coordinator.
- Management has the right to refuse entry to anyone who is perceived to present a safety or security risk.



Behavior that violates the above rules may result in a suspension from the pool or expulsion from the pool for the remainder of the season. No refunds will be issued.
